A Note about supplements. If you would like to add an audio visual aspect to this study, I highly recommend the Drive Thru History Holy Lands DVD set for the Ancients. I've never found an excellent video supplement for the Middle Ages period, although there are some good [Parents, please preview!] Videos about Medieval castles and knight training on YouTubeTM. Also please be careful with any documentaries covering the wars of the twentieth century. I do not feel comfortable recommending anything for this time period, simply because they tend to be graphic and gory. I prefer to leave that up to the parents.

^{*} The books chosen to be used in the "Importance of YOU in History" section were carefully selected to get your teen thinking about their God-given role in HIStory. Simply have your student read a section a week and journal their thoughts about it. At the end of each book, discuss what they have learned. Depending on when your student begins this study, there may be access to podcast recordings that I am going to create for the World History class I teach IRL.
